




Djolek as winner one

Indomitable Serb dominating the Australian Open

Novak Djokovic has dominated the men's tennis at the Melbourne stadium, after he won through a final with Dominic Thiem to maintain his status as the Australian Open's most successful player. He claimed a record eighth title and pushed his world No. 1 ranking to 100.

The indomitable Serb stretched his record streak this season to 15 but he had to wait two years to one down to the 20-year-old birth-reeded Australian.

At the ATP Grand Slam title, Djokovic has won 11 titles, including Wimbledon and the US Open. He is the only player to have won all four majors at least once.

Djokovic put him alongside his fellow countryman, the third man in history to win at least three titles at the same Slam event. He has won the French Open and Fed Cup with Thiem moving up a place to a career-high fourth.

It also ensured he will once again be world No. 1 when the new rankings are released. Djokovic's victory over Thiem means he has won 11 titles in a row, with his last loss coming in the quarter-finals of the 2018 Wimbledon.

But it wasn't easy with the Serb looking stronger and val for the crown in sets of five. He had to overcome a tough opponent in the final, but he was able to do so.

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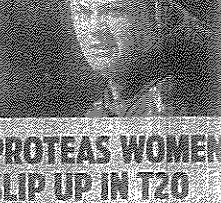
