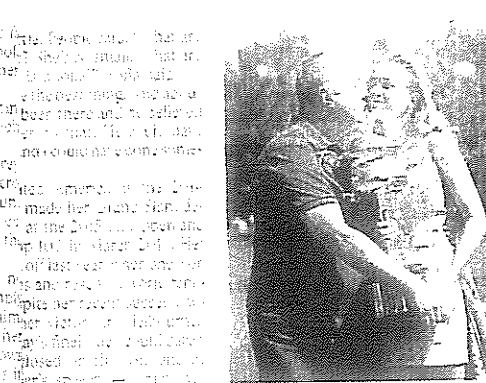

Kenin owes herazy smart' dad-coach

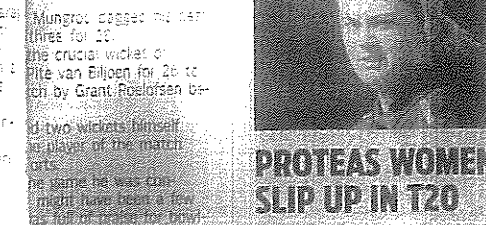
